INFO FOR A SMOOTH WORKSHOP

Venue & Space

A large space like a school hall is ideal. We require a minimum of 1 square meter per drum set-up. To continue providing the best experience, we have a maximum of 34 drums we can bring at any one time.

Equipment

Our facilitator provides all necessary drumming equipment. A power outlet is required for their equipment.

In order to ensure the correct amount of equipment you must give us your timetable and class numbers to complete a workshop booking. Please note that if you require more than 20 drums, an additional charge may apply.

Sessions & Breaks

For school workshops, our sessions generally run for 30-40 minutes, depending on the number of classes involved. Our facilitator requires a 15-minute small break and a 30-minute lunch break.

Noise Reduction

We typically use a snare drum or tom with a rubber practice pad on top. This setup provides a realistic drumming experience while reducing noise.

Facilitator Vetting & Reporting

All our facilitators are Garda vetted. If you require proof, please do not hesitate to ask. Our course director, Eimhin, is a primary school teacher and is happy to provide a cúntas míosúil if you require one.

Outdoor Workshops

These are possible in suitable weather and work great, but an indoor space is required as a backup. Unfortunately, we cannot confirm any outdoor workshop booking without a backup indoor venue in place.

Payment

An invoice will be sent before the workshop, and payment is due within 30 days via EFT (bank transfer). Email us for a full quote.

Cancellations or rescheduling

We charge an admin fee of €25 for a reschedule.
